

- No tuition increase for Vermonters since 2019, keeping costs frozen for seven consecutive years
- The UVM Promise ensures students from Vermont households earning \$100,000 or less pay no tuition at UVM

 More than half of Vermont households are eligible
- 46% of UVM undergraduate students from Vermont attend tuition-free due to direct financial support
- 91% of Vermont undergraduate students receive scholarships or financial aid
- 93% of Vermont first-year students return for their sophomore year
- 70% of Vermont students graduate from UVM in four years
