7 (a) Vermont residents may apply for licenses on forms provided by the
8 Commissioner. Fees for each license shall be:

11 (o) If the Board determines that it is necessary to issue or require additional
12 big game tags or big game permits that are not otherwise identified in this
13 section, the Department may issue such tags and permits and may assess a
14 provisional fee for such tags and permits at an amount equal or similar to the
15 fee for the same big game. The Department shall seek legislative approval of
16 the provisional fee pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 603 within one year following the
17 Department’s assessment of the fee. The Department’s failure to obtain
18 legislative approval of the provisional fee shall void the provisional fee and the
19 Department shall not assess a new provisional fee for the same big game tag or
20 big game permit.

1 (p) The Commissioner may assess the following fees for the use of
2 Department of Fish and Wildlife lands and facilities. All fees or charges
3 collected for the use of Department of Fish and Wildlife lands and facilities
4 shall be deposited in the Fish and Wildlife Fund:
