

Recovery Service Organization – Proposed Report Language

The purpose of this report is to provide the Vermont Agency of Human Services and the Legislature with a full understanding of the financial health of Vermont's Recovery Service Organizations.

As used in this section, "Recovery Services Organization(s)" means a non-residential and non-clinical facility providing recovery support services to individuals in recovery from substance use disorder and has a grant agreement with the Department of Health.

On or before February 15, 2027, the Department of Health shall, in consultation with other departments of the Agency of Human Services and recovery services organizations, provide a report to the House Committees on Appropriations, on Health Care and on Human Services and to the Senate Committees on Appropriations and on Health and Welfare with information on total actual income and expenditures for recovery services organizations in state fiscal years 2024, 2025, and 2026

(1) The report shall include information on the following:

- (A) fund source, including all State appropriated funds, federal funds, and funds from all other sources including but not limited to, fundraising, donations, and municipal funding;
- (B) the recipients of the funds specified in subdivision (1)(A) of this section or otherwise designated for recovery services
- (C) for State and federal funding, the amount of monies appropriated from the funds specified in subdivision (1)(A) of this section or otherwise designated for recovery services organizations that have been obligated;
- (D) for State and federal funding, the amount of monies appropriated from the funds specified in subdivision (1)(A) of this section or otherwise designated for recovery services organizations that have been drawn down as of June 30, 2026;
- (E) for all other funding sources specified in subdivision (1)(A) of this section or otherwise designated for recovery services organizations, the amount of monies that have been acquired; and
- (F) for all other funding sources specified in subdivision (1)(A) of this section or otherwise designated for recovery services organizations, the amount of monies that have been expended.

(2) The report shall also include:

- (A) an analysis of recovery services organization grant performance measures and outcomes for fiscal years 2024, 2025, and 2026; and

(B) any recommendations for enhancing the financial stability of recovery services organizations.
