Systemwide Statistics and Impact (FY24 Data)

- **Employees:** 16,138
- Employed Providers: 1,842
- Licensed Beds: 1,465
- Outpatient Care Sites: 141
- Patient Care Encounters: 2,584,887
- ED Visits: 181,611
- Active Clinical Trials/Studies: 1,245

Projected Regional Economic Impact

- Total Impact (Direct and Indirect): \$3.5 billion
- Jobs Supported: 23,600
- Tax Revenue Generated: \$432 million
- Community Benefit Impact: \$432 million


