# Impact of Federal Funding Freezes & Cuts April 7, 2025

Vermont's 14 Natural Resources Conservation Districts (NRCDs) form a statewide conservation delivery system designed to work directly with communities to identify local natural resources concerns and help individual land stewards secure technical expertise and funding to address those concerns. To do this work, NRCDs partner closely with federal agencies, particularly the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). While conservation districts have been able to leverage federal funding towards project work and provide technical services to farmers, municipalities, and other land stewards, this reliance on federal agencies paired with insufficient base funding has left them vulnerable to federal funding freezes, government shutdowns, and potential future funding cuts.

Currently, about **\$4.75 million** of funding to NRCDs and the Vermont Association of Conservation Districts (VACD) is in jeopardy, including **\$400,000 in cancelled grant awards** and **\$3.6 million of frozen payments and frozen grant agreements**.

## Services to Farmers, Landowners, & Other Land Stewards

NRCD and VACD staff provide technical assistance to farmers and other land stewards to assess natural resource concerns on their lands, identify solutions, navigate permitting processes, and secure funding for project installation. NRCD and VACD staff also provide administrative support to USDA NRCS, DEC, and VAAFM, enabling these agencies to run certain programs and execute contracts and grant agreements with farmers and other land stewards.

- \$2.1 million is frozen to the Vermont Association of Conservation Districts for technical assistance to farmers and NRCS program assistance statewide. This includes \$500,000 in frozen outstanding invoices for work already completed.
- \$263,000 for technical assistance to farmers in Essex, Caledonia, Orange, Windham, Windsor, and Bennington counties through White River NRCD and Windham NRCD is currently on hold under an NRCS RCPP agreement through American Farmland Trust (AFT).
- \$400,000 that supported a Climate Corps workforce development program through White River and Bennington NRCDs has been cancelled. This program was aimed at training young people in skills needed to support agricultural producers in implementing practices that help mitigate the impacts of extreme weather events and adapt to a changing climate.

If federal funding is reduced in the future, the Natural Resources Conservation Districts and VACD would lose capacity to provide direct services to farmers for things like conservation planning, GIS and drone services, soil sampling, and federal program navigation. If federal funding is eliminated, we would lose approximately **27 FTEs** statewide, which would result in a significant reduction of services to farmers and other working lands managers.

### Infrastructure & Clean Water Projects

NRCDs are project implementers for the state's Clean Water projects, including culvert replacements, dam removals, stormwater system installations, wetland restorations, and floodplain reconnection projects. Many of these projects – particularly large-scale infrastructure projects – include federal funding as part of the overall budget. Currently, **\$1.23 million** is frozen that would support culvert replacements in conjunction with state Clean Water Funds.

- **\$1.19 million** to Essex NRCD through a US Fish and Wildlife Service grant to promote fish passage. This project supports a new culvert in the town of Lunenburg and replacement of
- \$40,000 to Orleans County NRCD for culvert replacements in the Upper Missisquoi.

Federal funding for clean water, stormwater, and flood mitigation projects comes through a variety of sources, including the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). If those funding sources disappear, this would reduce districts' ability to do this work by roughly **50%**. We would see increased demand on the Clean Water Fund and other state funding sources to compensate for the absence of federal funding.
