Senator Ram Hinsdale moves that the Senate concur in the House proposal of amendment with further proposal amendment as follows:

First: In Sec. 1, 9 V.S.A. chapter 61A, in section 2415a, in subdivision (b)(42), by striking out subdivision (B) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (B) to read as follows:

(B) “Publicly available information” does not include:

- (i) biometric data collected by a business about a consumer without the consumer’s knowledge;
- (ii) any obscene visual depiction, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 1460;
- (iii) genetic data, unless otherwise made publicly available by the consumer to whom the information pertains; or
- (iv) intimate images, authentic or computer generated, known to be nonconsensual.

Second: In Sec. 1, 9 V.S.A. chapter 61A, in section 2415c, in subdivision (a)(21), by striking out the words “that is established to detect and prevent fraudulent acts in connection with insurance”
