2 An act relating to service of writs of possession

3 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

4 Sec. 1. 12 V.S.A. § 4854 is amended to read:

5 § 4854. JUDGMENT FOR PLAINTIFF; WRIT OF POSSESSION

6 If the court finds that the plaintiff is entitled to possession of the premises,
7 the plaintiff shall have judgment for possession and rents due, damages, and
8 costs, and when a written rental agreement so provides, the court may award
9 reasonable attorney's fees. A writ of possession shall issue on the date
10 judgment is entered, unless the court for good cause orders a stay. The writ
11 shall direct ~~the any sheriff of the county in which the property or a portion~~
12 ~~thereof is located~~ to serve the writ upon the defendant and, not earlier than
13 14 days after the writ is served, to put the plaintiff into possession.
