My family moved from a city where gun violence was a regular part of life. One of the reasons we chose Vermont was because of its reputation as a safe, welcoming place to raise children. That sense of safety is something I value deeply and think is worth protecting.

As a parent, I think often about how policies can help prevent dangerous situations before they escalate. I appreciate that H.606 focuses on areas like illegal firearm conversion devices, gun trafficking pathways, and access to firearms in situations where there is a clear risk of harm. These feel like thoughtful and practical steps aimed at prevention.

To me, this bill is about maintaining the kind of communities that families move here for — places where safety is not taken for granted, but actively supported through responsible policy. I hope the Committee will support moving H.606 forward.
