As a practicing lawyer in Vermont for 30 years, I write this letter in support of Governor Scott's nomination of Christina Nolan as an Associate Justice to the Vermont Supreme Court. I have known Christina since 2010 when she joined the United States Attorney's Office in Vermont, where I was then practicing as an Assistant United States Attorney. I remained in touch with Christina when I left the United States Attorney's Office at the end of 2016, and I encouraged her to join our firm, Sheehey Furlong & Behm, P.C. when she left the United States Attorney's Office in 2021.
