
State Land Mobile Radio (LMR) networks

- Maintains networks for SOV agencies: DPS, AOT, ANR
- Maintains mobile and portable radios for SOV users
- Used by first responders from many non-SOV agencies

Tower sites

- Over 40 towers for LMR service, most on mountain tops
- Microwave network connecting towers
- Used by many local dispatch agencies for their LMR networks DPS telephone system
- Over 700 lines including in PSAPs and DPS administrative offices
 Interoperability
- VCOMM Interoperable LMR network for first responders
- Subject matter expertise support for local and county officials
