<b>5</b>	Permits detainees to obtain a replacement learner's permit upon release from prison	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to, to be reviewed by Senate Institutions</li> </ul>
<b>6</b>	Grant authority to Commissioner of Corrections to work with DMV to provide credentials pursuant to Secs. 1-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to, to be reviewed by Senate Institutions</li> </ul>
<b>7</b>	Permits DMV to temporarily suspend a license or registration if an electronic payment does not go through	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On hold, waiting for more information from DMV on process</li> </ul>

8	Increases penalties for operating a prohibited vehicle in Smuggler's Notch to \$10,000 for a first offense and \$20,000 if traffic is substantially impeded.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
9	Permits electronic signatures on certain documents needed to provide a salvage title to an insurer after a vehicle is declared a total loss	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
10	Permits DMV to hand a person a duplicate motor vehicle title if they are at a DMV location	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
11	Permits DMV to hand a person a duplicate vessel, snow mobile, or ATV title if they are at a DMV location	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> <li>Current definition of title for that chapter needs a technical update because it does not include snow mobiles and vessels</li> <li>Will add definition in next draft</li> </ul>
12	Technical change to clarify where title appeals are filed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
13	Technical change to clarify exemptions from motor vehicle title requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
14	Permits AOT to seek \$250 reimbursement for towing costs from DMV	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
15	Technical change to numbering in section governing computation of diesel fuel tax	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Agreed to</li> </ul>
16	Definitions for purchase and use tax (PUT). Clarifies definition of purchase price. Makes technical change to definition of taxable cost for consistency with changes made in last year's Misc. MV bill. Adds definitions of month, year, shipping weight, trailer, and trailer coach.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Replacing definition of shipping weight with definition of Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) in next draft</li> </ul>
17	Clarifies how weight is determined for trucks subject to PUT. Clarifies that trailers are subject to PUT. Would	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Updating to reflect new GVWR threshold for trucks.</li> </ul>

	exempt trailer coaches from the cap on PUT but provide that other trailers are subject to the cap.	
<b>18</b>	Increases penalty for a snowmobile that is not registered or lacks a TMA decal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to</li> </ul>
<b>19</b>	Permits State and municipal employees without a CDL to operate heavy trucks in an emergency.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updating to apply to all emergencies declared by Governor</li> </ul>
<b>20</b>	Creates a \$40 fee for a one-year nondomiciled CDL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to</li> </ul>
<b>21</b>	Adds requirement for placement of motorboat validation stickers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to</li> </ul>
<b>22</b>	Requires use of personal flotation devices between 11/1 and 4/30, except for hunting and bow fishing in less than 3ft of water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updating “permit” to “license”</li> </ul>
<b>23</b>	Defines kei truck and kei vehicle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to</li> </ul>
<b>24</b>	Establishes requirements and protections for operation of kei trucks and kei vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agreed to</li> </ul>
<b>25</b>	Requires amendment of inspection manual	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Holding open until after public hearing</li> <li>• DMV has requested flexibility to address unforeseen changes to the proposed rule amendments.</li> <li>• Sen. Perchlik may propose window tinting provisions</li> </ul>
