Re: Blodgett trail

Dear Calvin:

Please find this letter notice that the Town of Moretown intends to remove the gravel berm that was placed in the town right of way on the Blodgett trail that, according to personnel from the Agency of Natural Resources, was built with material from the brook.

Vermont Statute Title 19, Section 1111 (b), states in part: "It shall be unlawful to develop, construct, regrade or resurface any driveway, entrance, or approach, or build a fence or building, or deposit material of any kind within, or to in any way affect the grade of a highway right-of-way, or obstruct a ditch, culvert or drainage course that drains a highway, or fill or grade the land adjacent to a highway seast to divert the flow of water onto the highway right-of-way, without a written permit from the legislative body of the Town". In addition, please be advised that snow is considered material and can not be put or piled within a trail right-of-way, nor shall any object be left within the trail right-of-way writhout being considered obstructing travel.

Should you want to perform any work within a town right-of-way, you will first need a permit. I have attached an application.

The berm will be removed sometime between 7/11/11 and 10/1/11.
