Representatives Tagliavia of Corinth and Boyden of Cambridge move that the report of the Committee on Government Operations and Military Affairs be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, by striking out subsection (a) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (a) to read as follows:

(a) Authorization. The Board may grant event permits to licensed cannabis retail establishments in good standing. The holder of an event permit is authorized to oversee and administer a commercial event pursuant to this section and procedures adopted by the Board. No cannabis or cannabis products shall be consumed at an event authorized by this section.

Second: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, in subsection (b), in the first sentence, after “A licensed cannabis” by inserting the word “retail”

Third: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, by striking out subdivision (b)(6) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (b)(6) to read as follows:

(6) compliance with any other health and safety requirements that the Board may prescribe for the particular event or event location, including limits on attendees.

1        Fourth: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, in subsection (c), by striking out the first  
2        sentence in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new sentence to read  
3        “Annually, the Board shall issue not more than ten permits for public events.”

4        Fifth: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, in subsection (e), after the first usage of  
5        the word “Cannabis” by inserting the word “retail”

6        Sixth: In Sec. 5, 7 V.S.A. § 912, in subsection (f), by striking out the  
7        second sentence in its entirety.
