Shelter in Place Training in Personal Safety
If you need to shelter in Place, consider the following:
In your Office:
Shut and Lock your door (if you don't have a lock consider a wedge under the door)
•
Turn off your lights
•
Close any shades especially those off the hallway
•
Conceal yourself in a place where you cannot easily be seen from the door or outside
•
If possible, quietly notify other people in the building
•
If possible, Call Capitol Police 828-2229 quietly or call 911
•
Stay sheltered until you get an all-clear from Law Enforcement
•
Don't take any action that would put you in harm's way
•
If you Away from your office:
Seek shelter in a nearby office or in an area that has been identified as secure, such as a supply room with a locking door.
•
Avoid hallways or open area such as cubicles, lobbies or conference rooms
•
Turn off the lights

SAFTY TIP TO SHELTER IN PLACE

Conceal yourself so that you cannot be easily seen from the doorway If possible, quietly notify other people in the building of the event If possible, Call Capitol Police 828-2229 quietly or call 9-911 Stay sheltered until you get an all clear from Law Enforcement If you can safely shelter a client or visitor you should do so, but never leave a secure area if you are already sheltered You can practice sheltering by yourself or with a group....just work out a plan and practice regularly It is important to always wear your ID badge-responders to an incident are going to want to identify employees immediately If you are caught out in the open and you have no place to shelter, drop to the floor, turn your face towards a wall, and play dead
