16	(a) The Vermont Traumatic Brain Injury Fund is established in the Office
17	of the State Treasurer as a special fund to be a source of financing for services
18	for individuals with TBI and for programs established by or through contracts
19	with the Agency of Human Services for the treatment of traumatic brain
20	injuries.

1	(b) Into the Fund shall be deposited \$5.00 from the surcharge imposed
2	under 13 V.S.A. § 7282(d), proceeds from grants, donations, contributions,
3	taxes, and any other sources of revenue as may be provided by statute, rule, or
4	act of the General Assembly.
