Subject: Fish and game; hunting; use of light

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the use of a light to spot, locate, take, or attempt to take a coyote.

An act relating to authorizing the use of a light to hunt coyotes

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 4702 is amended to read:

§ 4702. USE OF LIGHT

A person shall not intentionally throw or cast the rays of a spotlight, jack, or other artificial light on any highway, or any field, woodland, or forest, in order to spot, locate, take, or attempt to take, spot, or locate any wild animal.

However, a light may be used to take skunks, coyotes, and raccoons in accordance with rules of the Board

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
